Paper Based Exam:

The main objective of these series of paper based exam is to make them prepared to sit in the SLC exam with a higher level of confidence. The exam will be based totally on the SLC curriculum and the model answers provided after each exam will help them to have an idea of getting high scores on the final examination.

Online Exam:

Online exam is the new concept of Brush-Up Online which has been started from last year. Students can take the online exam from anywhere as per their comfort abiding by the provided exam code. 50 objective questions will be asked from all the sections and have to be finished within 1 hour. The result will be published in the students' profile and also will be sent to their e-mails within an hour. The exam registration process and other documentation will be provided by their respective computer teachers during the time of the enrollment.

Read these rules: Failure to comply with the following rules can result in an expulsion from the exam and possible disqualification for the respective exam.

Instructions to the Candidate:

You must...

1. Bring Brush-Up admit card to the examination centre.
2. Leave the personal belongings outside the hall at your own risk.
3. Arrive at test center 15 minutes before the scheduled exam time.
4. Filled the answer sheets as per instructions on them.
5. Confirm your presence in the exam by registering the attendance.
6. Handover the answer sheets to the invigilator before leaving the hall.

You must not...

1. Be late for more than 15 minutes after the commencement of exam, if you arrive late:
 - you may not be admitted to hall.
 - you may not be allowed to take any of the exam components.
 - you may not be eligible for refund.
2. Carry any type of electronic gadgets (e.g. mobile, pager, I pod, pen drive etc.)
3. Bring any paper (blank/written) and carry bags.
4. Talk or disturb any candidate.
5. Lend anything to, or borrow anything from, another candidate during the examination.
6. Remove any pages from the answer booklet.
7. Write name, symbol no. on any other page than where required. Any type of indication mark placed elsewhere will breach code of conduct.
8. Engage in any form of mal practices which may damage the integrity and security of Brush-Up examination.
9. Violate the rule of Brush-Up exams. Candidate violating the rule will face expulsion from the exam hall and may be liable to legal action.
10. Contravene exam rules by, for example cheating, helping another candidate to cheat or by carrying materials or items with you that could give you an unfair advantage. This is likely to result in your exam paper being voided. It may also result in the termination of your Brush-Up exam and your respective school may take disciplinary action against you.
